### Internationalization

1. **Title of the practice** – Internationalization
2. **Objectives of the practice (In 400 words)** – To provide diversity in the classes of our students so that they become responsible global citizens.
3. **The Context (In 150 words)** – In line with the SIU mission of „Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam“, one of the primary goals at SCMS, Pune is to make the students responsible global citizens. The Internationalization of the SCMS, Pune campus is in the form of full time International students, Semester Exchange students from foreign universities, SCMS students going to foreign universities and also through various initiatives on campus such as workshops, certificate programs and guest lectures. The SCMS campus is a very diverse campus. There are full time international students from 31 different countries on the campus plus many Non Resident Indian students
4. **The Practice (In 400 words)** –
  - a. **GIP-** At SCMS, the fourth semester has been identified as the „Global Immersion Program „semester. During the GIP semester, SCMS students have the freedom to complete any 12 credits of their choice from a partner university of SIU across the globe. These credits are accepted at SCMS.
  - b. **Summer School-** Some SCMS students also choose to attend Summer schools and other short term programs. SCMS facilitates this by offering attendance assistance etc. SCMS students have attended summer schools at universities such as, Harvard University, London School of Economics, Dance summer school at Trinity Laban, UK, Fudan University, Shanghai, China and more.
  - c. **Buddy Committee-** Buddy committee is a body of the international cell formed of 14-16 members from 1st, 2nd and 3rd year. The main objective is to help international students adjust to their new home. As a new student, it is always difficult adapting to a new and different environment, Buddy is able to show typical Indian traditions and is able to explain why things are the way they are. He/she can also help out with some practical issues faced by foreign national students. Most important, Buddies are the friends, guides, mentors and definitely hang out peers. They make an atmosphere of home away from home for the new students.
  - d. **Study India Program-** SCMS has hosted students from different university for study India program. In the past SCMS has hosted following university students- The students of Deakin University, Australia had visited the Institute for a six-day study tour on the subject “Investment and Portfolio Analysis” from 20th November to 25th November 2017, 2018 & 2019. Their study started from what were investments to understanding security instruments, Financial and capital markets, Portfolio creation, Fundamental and Technical analysis. They had an industry tour as well where they were taken to PwC/

KPMG and were given an insight into Investment Banking in India. A contingent of 16 students from Liege School of Commerce, Belgium accompanied by their Professors visited Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies, Pune on 15 March 2018. They were traditionally welcomed by the students and faculty of SCMS Pune. The Liège faculty and students presented the business initiatives of the Belgium firms intending to make a foray into Indian market. The faculty of SCMS-Pune also took a session on “Doing Business in India.

- e. **International Faculty-** SCMS has also hosted foreign faculties with expertise in different fields.
- f. **COIL** – From the academic year 2019 – 20, SCMS Pune initiated the COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) with a US University, where students from both the institutes were co-taught a module and co-worked on a project by leveraging ICT (Information and Communication Technology). This was included in their internal assessment.

**5. Evidence of success (In 200 words) –**

- a. Number of outgoing and incoming students has gone up gradually over the years.
- b. The diversity in the campus has also increased, we have students from over 30 different countries studying in the campus.
- c. The study India program of Deakin University has now become a regular activity
- d. The COIL Collaboration has been done for two consecutive semesters and we have started planning for the third collaboration.

**6. Problems encountered and the resources required (In 150 words) –**

- a. The International students seem to face problems related to culture, food, health, etc. so managing them sometimes is a challenge.
- b. The International students also face problems related to the FRO process since it changes frequently and the students have to visit them multiple times.
- c. In case of COIL, the time difference seems to be a major challenge, in addition it takes some time for the students to understand each other’s culture and traditions and start working together



## COIL Report – August – September 2019

### Participating Institutions – SCMS Pune (SIU) and Bridge Valley Community College, US

#### The Initiation of doing COIL

The initiation of the COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) was marked by a session conducted at SIU on COIL on 4 April, 2019 from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm titled "An Introduction to COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning)" by Prof. Jon Rubin one of the founding practitioners of COIL. In the session we were provided the details of Prof. Austin O'Connor regarding a possible COIL Collaboration, which seemed interesting since the subject matched with one of our subjects at SCMS.

#### The Initial Meeting – tackling possible issues

The initiation of doing COIL was followed by a mail being sent on 17 April, 2019 by Prof. Vijay P. Misra to Prof. Austin O'Connor regarding the possibility of Collaborating for COIL to which Prof. Austin replied positively and we decided to keep our first virtual meeting on 7 May, 2019 on WebEx which was joined by Dr. Adya Sharma – Director, SCMS Pune, Dr. Jon Rubin, Director – COIL Connect, Dr. Sherry Ritter, COIL director at BridgeValley CTC, Dr. Austin O'Connor, Faculty for Microeconomics at BridgeValley and Prof. Vijay P. Misra, Faculty of Principles of Microeconomics at SCMS Pune.

**Cohort Size** – SCMS Pune – 30 Students and BridgeValley – 20 Students

#### The COIL in Progress

- The COIL initiative started as decided with an initial introductory session conducted by Dr. Sherry Ritter, talking to the students of SCMS and getting them familiar with the usage of the Blackboard.
- The students were asked to provide their introduction on the Blackboard under the tab "ice breaker discussion".
- This was followed by a lecture session by Dr. Peter for SMCS students regarding the Health Care Delivery Systems in the US. Similarly, Prof. Vijay P. Misra conducted a lecture session for the BridgeValley students on the Health Care Delivery Systems in India. These sessions were conducted with the objective of providing the students with some insights for them to work on their COIL projects.
- The students were expected to interact with each other and share their views on the Blackboard, so that they would get familiar and be ready to work in groups for the final submission. The students did interact but not to the extent we had expected, so we decided to put them into groups so that the interactions would improve.
- Our final attempt to get the students to interact was making different groups tab on the Blackboard, where each group students would interact with each other. We had a final of 6 group (4 SCMS Students and 3 BridgeValley Students on average) after the attrition.

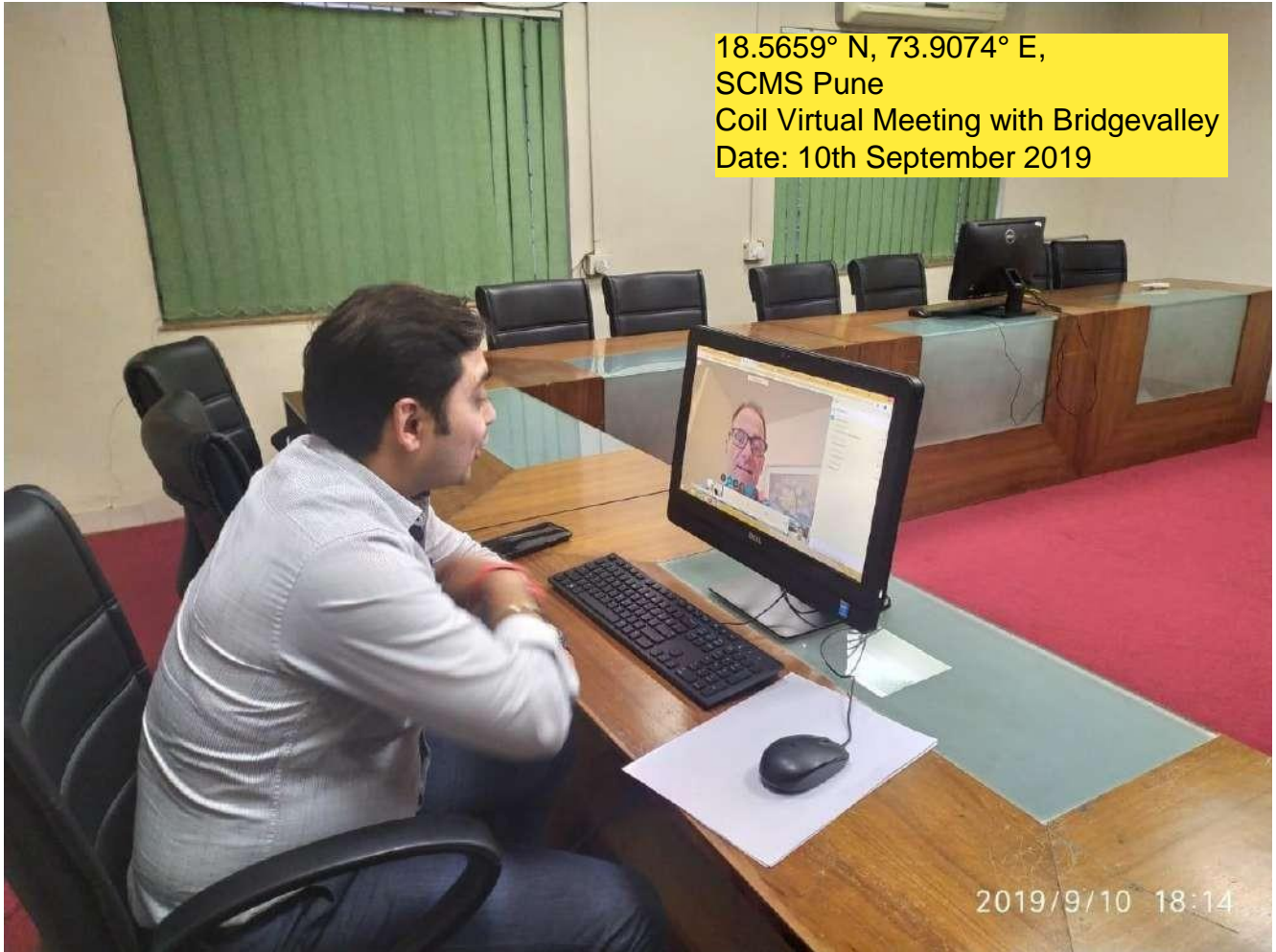

## COIL Report – March 2020

### Participating Institutions – SCMS Pune (SIU) and Bridge Valley Community College, US

#### COIL 2.0

With the success of COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) in the previous semester, it was only a natural progression to take it forward to the next semester. This time the students were different and so was the course (Macroeconomics), since both the faculty from the two Institutes who did COIL in the previous semester were teaching Macroeconomics in this semester, we mutually decided to go ahead with COIL 2.0 for Macroeconomics. The one objective that was definite is that we had to make attempts towards increasing student interaction.

**Cohort Size** – SCMS Pune – 22 Students and BridgeValley – 21 Students

#### The COIL in Progress

- The COIL initiative started as decided with dividing the students into groups at the very beginning, the objective was to increase student interaction. In addition, the icebreaker activity was directed towards the same objective and students were expected to create a short story based on the character's in their group. Dr. Sherri Ritter from BridgeValley created the groups and also provided the Blackboard (LMS of BridgeValley) access to students and faculty from SCMS Pune.
- The initial introductory session was conducted by Dr. Pete, talking to the students of SCMS and getting them familiar with the COIL 2.0 and giving them an overview of what would be expected.
- The students were expected to submit their icebreaker activity as the first submission, it was expected that this would get the students familiar with each other and also get them geared up for the further submissions.
- This was followed by a lecture session by Dr. Peter for SCMS students regarding the Macroeconomic Situation in the US. This session was conducted with the objective of providing the students with some insights for them to work on their COIL projects.
- The final COIL submission was divided into 2 parts – in the first part students were expected to work on the concept of National Income and the sector wise contributions to National Income (in India and US), to identify how its similar/ different in the two countries w.r.t. sector wise contribution to National Income and employment generation by each sector. Also, they were expected to document components of Indian and American National Income by sector, the sectors are defined by US BEA or Indian Governmental authority.
- For the second part the students were expected to explore and explain income distribution statistics for each economy (US and India).
- The students were expected to interact with each other and share their views on the Blackboard, in their respective groups and submit the final document individually for the grading purpose.
- The final submission would be a compilation of all the previous submissions. Each group is expected to make one document which would include the following:

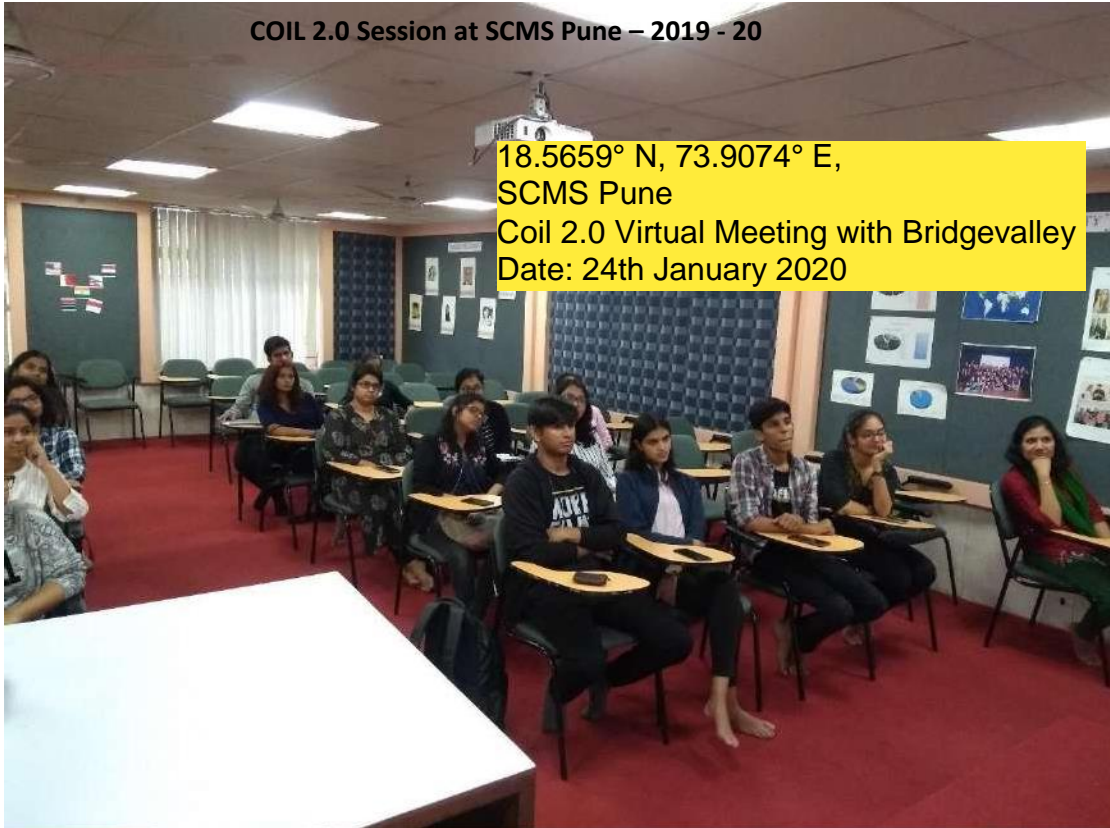


- Page 1 – Names of Group members and Project Title – COIL Project Submission – February, 2020
- Page 2 – 3 – The Icebreaker Activity – (which the groups had ready done)
- Page 4 onwards – Assignment I & Assignment II – the group had worked on these individually and for the final submission they had to just compile the same (which was a combination of Assignment I & Assignment II) in such a manner that it makes sense and a flow is there when we read the Final Submission.
- The students were informed not add anything new, but to put all the parts together in a manner that it makes sense to the reader.
- Finally, we saw that this time there was greater interaction among the students, which we had planned for. In addition, all the groups had worked and made the submissions – thus, in COIL 2.0 all the students were given marks and we observed greater participation. Moving ahead we would try and make this activity more fun and hope the students would have a better learning experience.
