- 1. Title of the practice Internationalization
- **2. Objectives of the practice (In 400 words)** To provide diversity in the classes of our students so that they become responsible global citizens.
- 3. The Context (In 150 words) In line with the SIU mission of "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam", one of the primary goals at SCMS, Pune is to make the students responsible global citizens. The Internationalization of the SCMS, Pune campus is in the form of full time International students, Semester Exchange students from foreign universities, SCMS students going to foreign universities and also through various initiatives on campus such as workshops, certificate programs and guest lectures. The SCMS campus is a very diverse campus. There are full time international students from 31 different countries on the campus plus many Non Resident Indian students

4. The Practice (In 400 words) –

- a) **GIP-** At SCMS, the fourth semester has been identified as the "Global Immersion Program "semester. During the GIP semester, SCMS students have the freedom to complete any 12 credits of their choice from a partner university of SIU across the globe. These credits are accepted at SCMS.
- b) International Cell (Buddy Committee)- Buddy committee is a body of the international cell freelof 14-16 members from 1st, 2nd and 3rd year. The main objective is tohelp international students adjust to their new home. As a new student, it is always difficult adapting to a new and different environment, Buddy is able to show typical Indian traditions and is able to explain why things are the way they are. He/she can also help out with some practical issues faced by foreign national students. Most important, Buddies are the friends, guides, mentors and definitely hang out peers. They make an atmosphere of home away from home for the new students.
- c) **International Faculty-** SCMS has also hosted foreign faculties with expertise in different fields.
- d) COIL From the academic year 2018 –19, SCMS Pune initiated the COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) with a US University, where students from both the institutes were co-taught a module and co-worked on a project by leveraging ICT (Information and Communication Technology). This was included in their internal assessment. In academic year 2020-21, COIL 3.0 collaborated with Bridge Valley.

5. Evidence of success (In 200 words) –

- a) Number of outgoing and incoming students has gone up gradually over the years.
- b) The diversity in the campus has also increased, we have students from over 30 different countries studying in the campus.
- c) The COIL Collaboration has been done for three consecutive semesters and we started with the fourth collaboration.

6. Problems encountered and the resources required (In 150 words) –

- a) The International students seem to face problems related to culture, food, health, etc. so managing them sometimes is a challenge.
- b) The International students also face problems related to the FRO process since it changes frequently and the students have to visit them multiple times.
- c) In case of COIL, the time difference seems to be a major challenge, in addition it takes some time for the students to understand each other's culture and traditions and start working together






















































CONCLUSION

With the success of COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) – 1.0 & 2.0 in the previous two semesters, it was only a natural progression to take it forward to the next semester. This time the students were different – the new batch of 2020, since both the faculty from the two Institutes who did COIL in the previous semesters were happy and convinced that COIL was something different and liked and appreciated by the students; also, given the COVID-19 Pandemic, COIL seemed to be a great way towards enabling internationalization and providing the required exposure to our students. The objective was very clear – that we had to focus on increasing the student interaction further to help the students understand and appreciated the cultural, traditional and other differences in the two places.

Cohort Size - SCMS Punc - 9 Students and BridgeValley - 6 Students

The COIL in Progress

- The COIL initiative started as decided with an initial introductory session conducted by Dr. Pete on 20 October, 2020; talking to the students of SCMS and getting them familiar with the usage of the Blackboard.
- The students were put into groups and were required to introduction on the Blackboard through an innovative method – each group was to interact amongst themselves and then create a poem/ story/ music/ video/ or any other creative piece. keeping all the characters of the group in their creation.
- This was followed by a combined lecture session by Dr. Peter & Prof. Vijay for all the students on 4 November, 2020, giving them insights on the current Pandemic situation and how it had effected the two economies, this would act as a base for the students to work on their COIL Submissions.
- The students were expected to interact with each other in their groups and share their submissions on the Blackboard in a weekly manner to progress towards the completion of the final COIL Submission.
- There was another combined lecture session by Dr. Peter & Prof. Vijay for all the students on 11 November, 2020 to understand what the students were doing and to guide the students in completion of the final COIL Submission.

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COIL Weekly Schedule

Week	Duration	Activity to be done
Week I	19 to 24 October, 2020	Finalization of the Students for COIL and providing the Blackboard Access to them to get familiar with the platform and submit the Ice-breaker activity (each group was to interact amongst themselves and then create a poem/ story/ music/ video/ or any other creative piece. keeping all the characters of the arrows in their creation).
Week II	26 to 31 October, 2020	Dealing with COVID-19 Role of Government and Industry - Students were to choose an industry and then a firm through with the state of the industry could be viewed, further to describe the impact that the pandemic has had on the firm.
Week III	2 to 7 November, 2020	Students would generate a list of suggested interventions that the government had taken that could minimize the risk of COVID exposure to consumers or labor at the firm and assure that the firm, and therefore the industry in general navigates the pandemic. Students were to consider strategies that increase demand or reduce costs of factor inputs for the firm.
Week IV	9 to 14 November, 2020	Completing the analysis form Week III. The students having analyzed the interventions by the government, now had to build strategies to help the firm they had chosen to remain afloat in this difficult times and make progress as the time goes ahead.
Week V	16 to 21 November, 2020	Final submissions were to be uploaded by the students on the Blackboard for the evaluation and completion of the COIL Collaboration.

Benefits to Students

- The students experienced virtual international exchange, which was the best possible mode
 of internationalization given the current situation.
- To acknowledge the efforts of the students who were active for COIL, their submissions
 were included as a part of their internal evaluation and they also received digital badges to
 show their achievement.

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Benefits to SCMS

- BridgeValley has indicated that they want to go ahead with another COIL initiative in the coming semester for Macroeconomics.
- Possibility of Student/ faculty exchanges in the future.

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

COIL 4.0

With the success of COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) – 1.0, 2.0 & 3.0 in the previous three semesters, it was only a natural progression to take it forward to this semester also. This time the students were from the batch of 2020 – 23 of SCMS Punc. Since both the faculty from the two Institutes who did COIL in the previous semesters were happy and convinced that COIL was something different and liked and appreciated by the students; also, given the COVID-19 Pandemic, COIL seemed to be a great way towards enabling internationalization and providing the required exposure to our students. The objective was very clear—that we had to focus on increasing the student interaction further to help the students understand and appreciate the cultural, traditional and other similarities/ differences in the two places.

Cohort Size - SCMS Pune - 28 Students and BridgeValley - 14 Students

The COIL in Progress

- The COIL initiative started with putting the students into Groups and providing all of the them the BlackBoard Access, all this happened between 19 & 22 March, 2021
- As decided, the first meeting with everyone was an initial introductory session conducted by Dr. Pete on 24 March, 2021; talking to the students of SCMS and BridgeValley and SCMS familiar with the usage of the Blackboard. Also, welcoming all the students to the COIL Collaboration.
- The students were already put into groups and were now required to go ahead with the Ice Breaker Activity Introduction on the Blackboard through an innovative method each group was to interact amongst themselves and then create a poem/ story/ music/ video/ or any other creative piece; keeping all the characters of the group in their creation.
- This was followed by the first Academic Activity, wherein each group had to explore the
 Macroeconomic Variable that would be required to understand the condition of the
 industry/ sector. The same would have to be presented on a single slide PPT (1 slide for
 US and 1 slide for India). The same has to be submitted on the BlackBoard.
- This was followed by a combined lecture session by Dr. Peter & Prof. Vijay for all the students on 14 April, 2021, giving them insights on what Macroeconomic Variables are and how they may be used to analyze an industry/ sector, this would act as a base for the

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- students to complete/ refine their first Academic Activity and also help them further with the COIL Submissions.
- The students were then introduced to their Final COIL Project wherein, they had to consider elaborating the single slide presentations (done under Academic Activity I) onto a word document detailing their interpretation and analysis of the individual macroeconomic indicators on the condition of the selected industry/ sector.
- The students had to finally conclude their COIL Projects by analyzing the current condition of the selected industry/ sector as per their analysis of the macroeconomic variables. They were encouraged to also bring out the similarities and differences of the condition of the industry/ sector in the two countries (USA & India). This final COIL Project had to be submitted on the BlackBoard by 24 April, 2021, (the date was further increased to 30 April, 2021).

In case of any delays the final COIL Project submission has to be done latest by 27 April, 2021. The grading of the same will be completed by 30 April, 2021 and the COIL – March – April, 2021 will conclude.

Changes made in COIL from 1.0 to 4.0

- Formation of Groups Immediately In our first COIL we initially asked the students to interact on the Discussion Forum on the BlackBoard and had decided to put the students into Groups only for the COIL Project. However, we realized that there was not much interaction among the students. The interaction did increase when they started working in the Groups. As a result in the subsequent COIL we put the students immediately after selecting the COIL students. This increased the interaction among the students which is evident from the Ice Breaker Activity submitted by the students and further helped in the COIL Project also.
- Joint Sessions by Faculty In the first and second COIL we used to keep independent sessions by Faculty from both the Institutes. This was aimed at providing the students the academic and theoretical knowledge required to complete the COIL Project. After that we decided to hold Joint sessions by the Faculty from both the Institutes and focused more on a discussion based approach to directly address the problem areas in the COIL Project and provide with more real world examples. This has helped in the student interaction and participation in these Sessions.



• Ice Breaker Activity (Compulsory Submission) — In our first COIL we had asked the students to introduce themselves on the Discussion Forum so that they would all get to know each other. Since it did not work too well, in the subsequent COIL we divided them into groups immediately (as discussed above) and also asked them to come up with an innovative way of introducing the Group on the BlackBoard (through a song/ video/ poem/ story/ etc.) which would have to include all the Group members. Since this was a compulsory submission, it set the interaction among the students at the very beginning.

Benefits to Students

- The students experienced virtual international exchange, which was the best possible mode of internationalization given the current situation.
- To acknowledge the efforts of the students who were active for COIL, their submissions
 were included as a part of their internal evaluation and they also received digital badges
 to show their achievement.

Benefits to SCMS

- BridgeValley has indicated that they want to go ahead with another COIL initiative in the coming semester for Macroeconomics.
- Possibility of Student/ faculty exchanges in the future.

Quaran-Teaming-Drammebaaz






