
Mr Jivitesh Jadwani (2011-2014)


SHASTRI CONFERENCE AND LECTURE SERIES GRANT






- Stuti Monga (2020-23) of Drammebaaz core secured First Place in Glam it Up event of FLAME Kurukshetra fest.




Step-up introduced two new branches namely K-Team featuring various dance performances from K-Pop artists and A-Team for alumni to participate and feel like a part of college once again!
