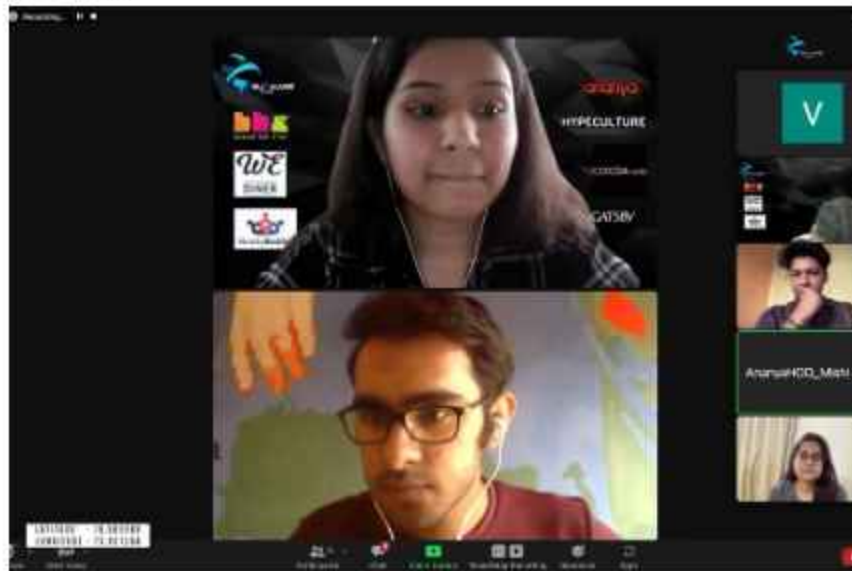


Event Summary:

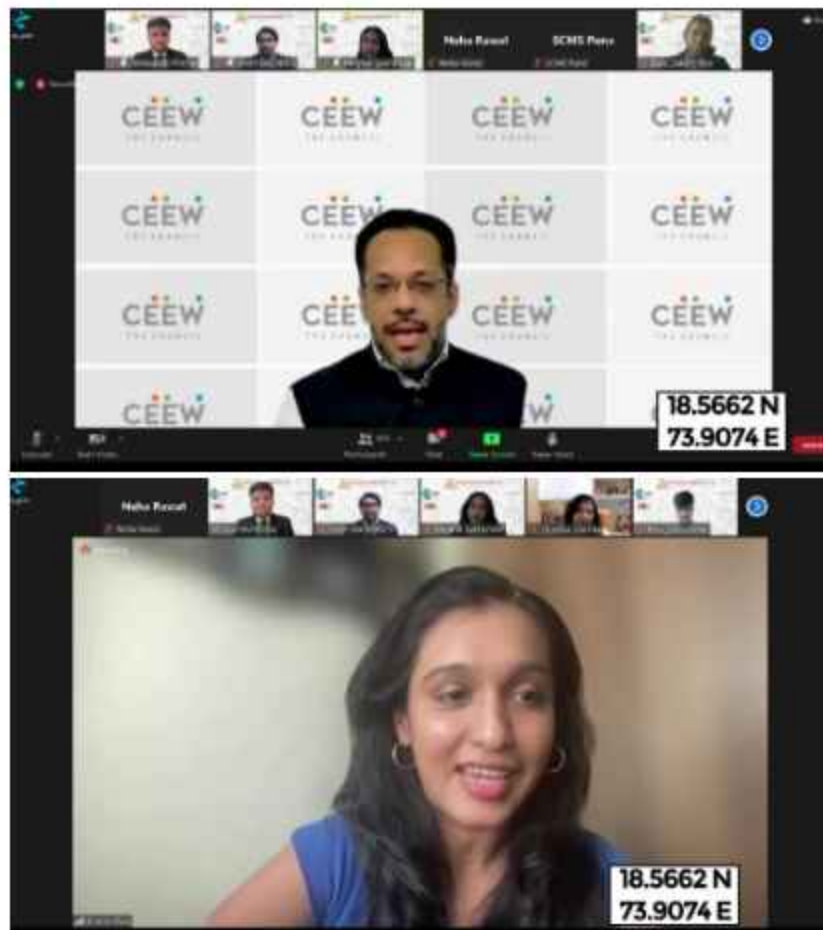
Event Summary:
