

# **Event Summary:**

The Cultural Wing of Sympulse, Ananya, hosted Fashion Fiest, an online fashion show. The event was held online on Zoom meetings and was hosted by Kashika Nagpal, a core member

of Ananya with Simran Kaur being in charge. The event started off with a warm welcome for Nayanika Chatterjee being introduced as the judge for this event. Participants had to take part in 2 rounds, where they needed to send entries depicting the theme "Mis-match" (colours and clothing items that are not compatible should be used to create outfits). In round 1, the participants had to walk the ramp like they own it and submit a 30 seconds reel directly to the provided mail-id. Participants were judged based on their clothing, makeup, walk, creativity, and personality. Participants were allowed to use transitions and cuts with the audio of their choice, however, no filters were allowed. In round 2, the teams had to use a prop based on the theme and depict the same in the best possible way by clicking photographs and submitting the same to the given mail-id. Participants were judged based on clothing, prop-use, posture, theme depiction.

Finalists were also required to send a compiled PDF of 3-5 pictures of their full costume (Front and Back) and a closeup of their face. Based on these criteria, the judge, Nayanika Chatterjee, declared Yuvraj Upadhyay as the winner of the event.
