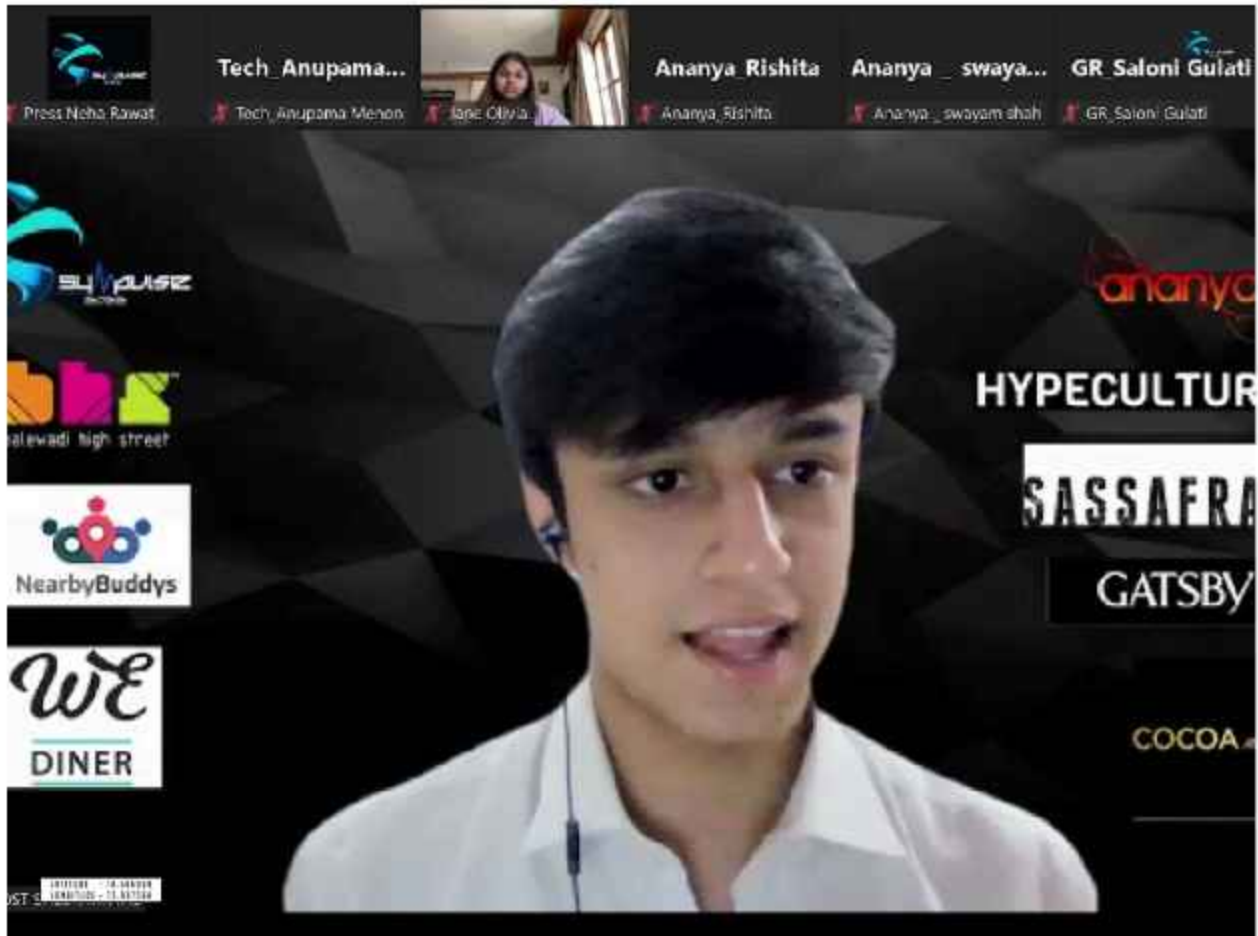

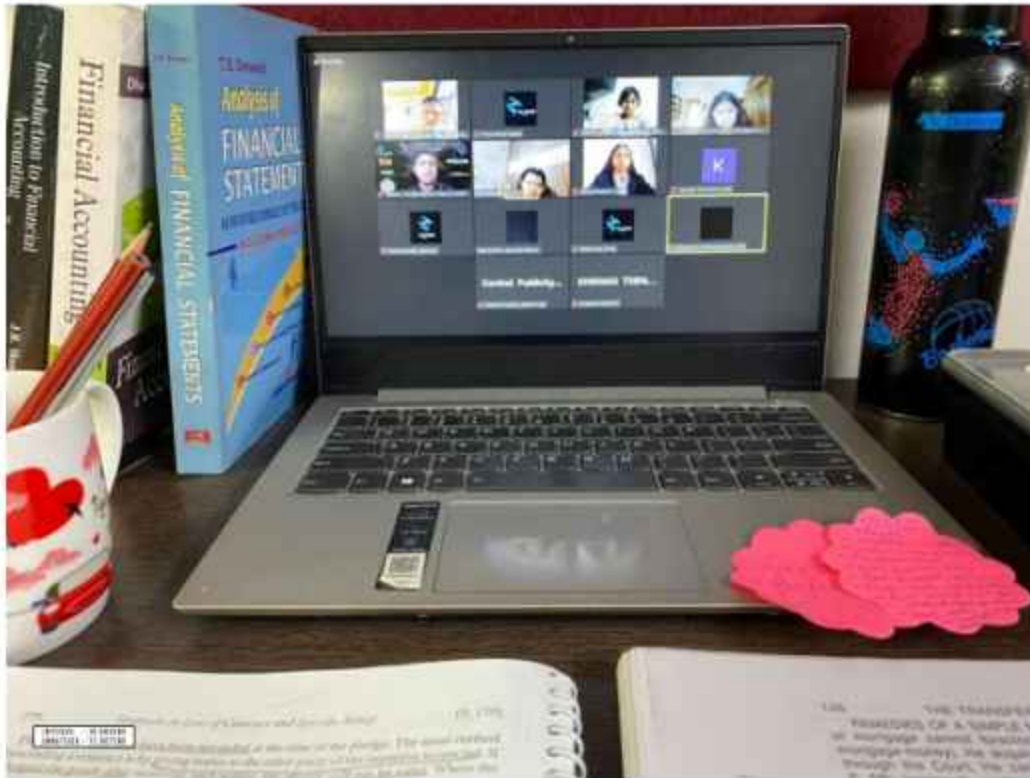

1. SIMUNC Opening Ceremony



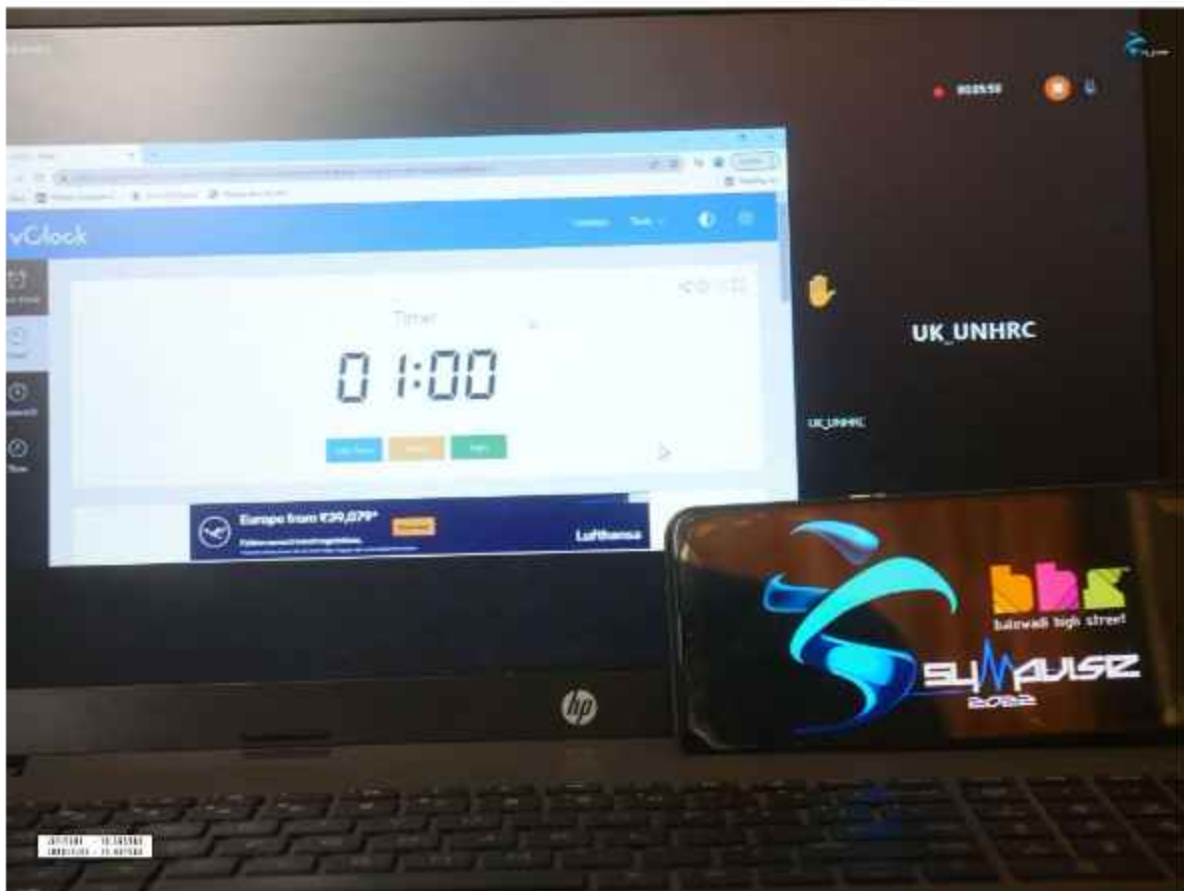

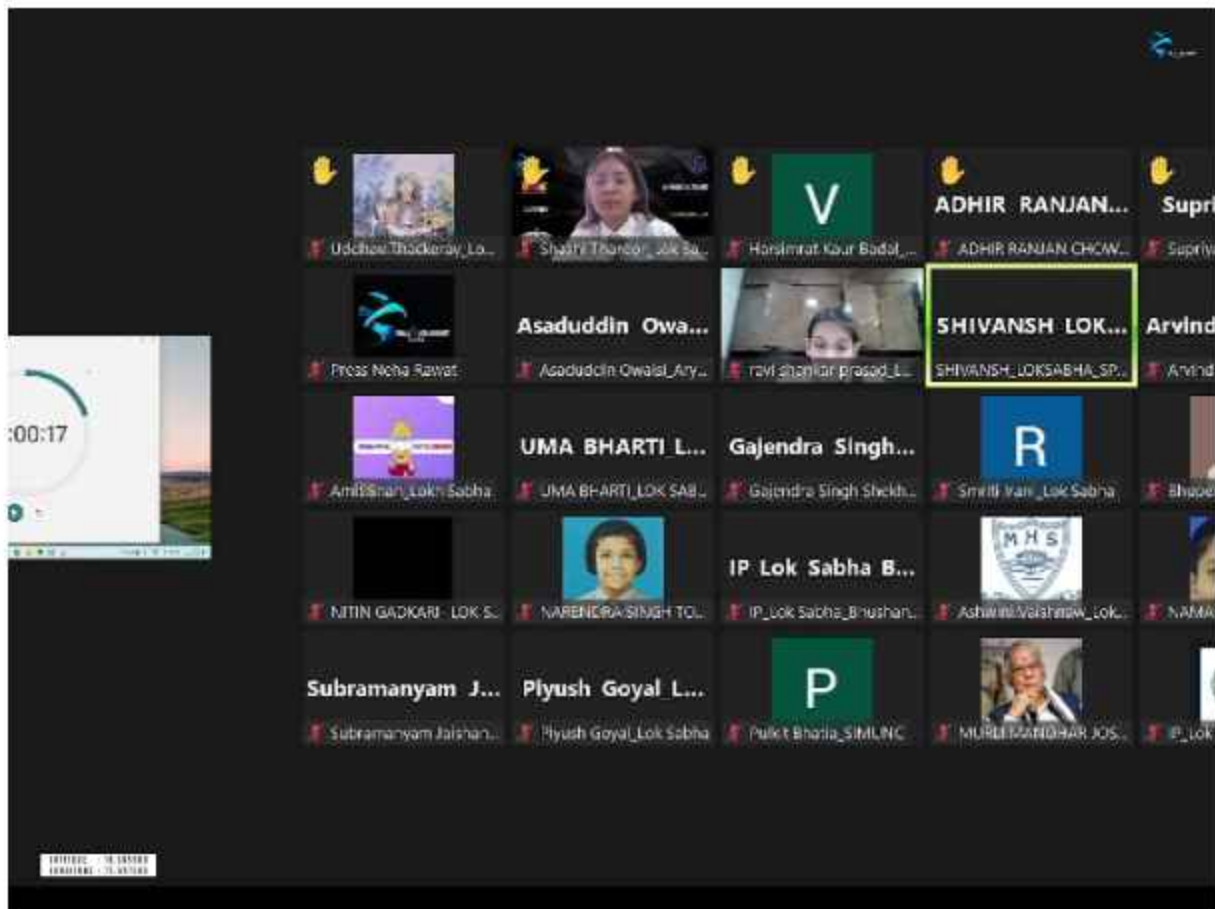
Event Summary:

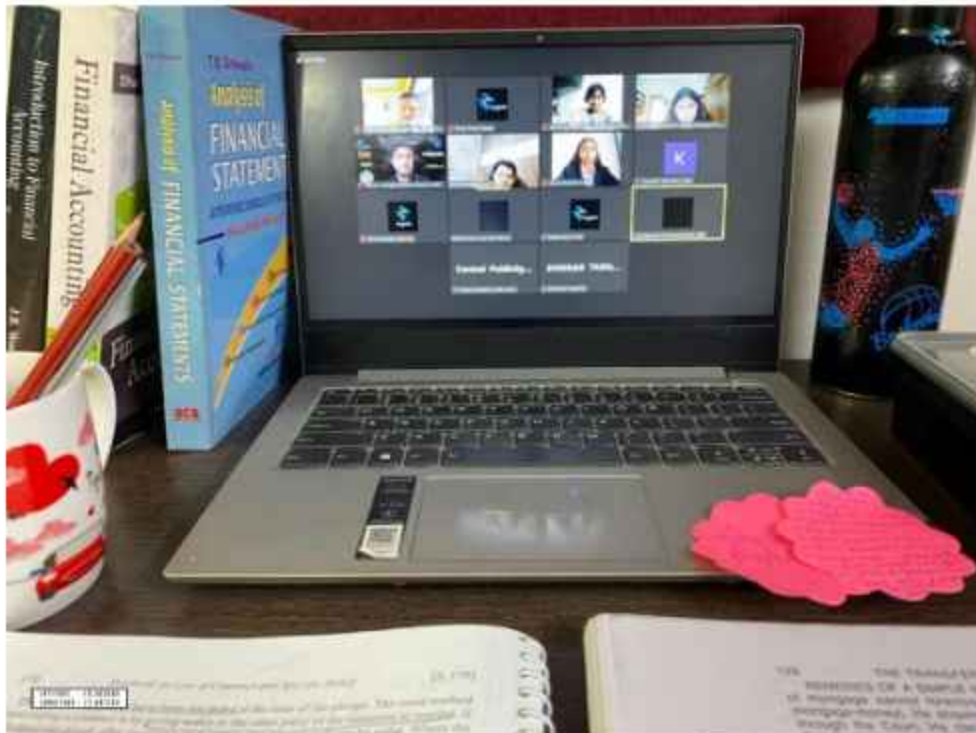
Event Summary:

The event began with Shivansh Srivastava, the Speaker addressing the delegates. Shivansh Srivastava is a final year law student from IP University, Delhi. He has chaired around 220+ conferences and has an MUN experience of more than 250 conferences.

The speaker began by taking the delegates through the rules of procedures which would be followed for both the days. The committee has been functioning with the parliamentary approach in the two sessions since the morning. The speaker began with the role call and then started with the opening statement. 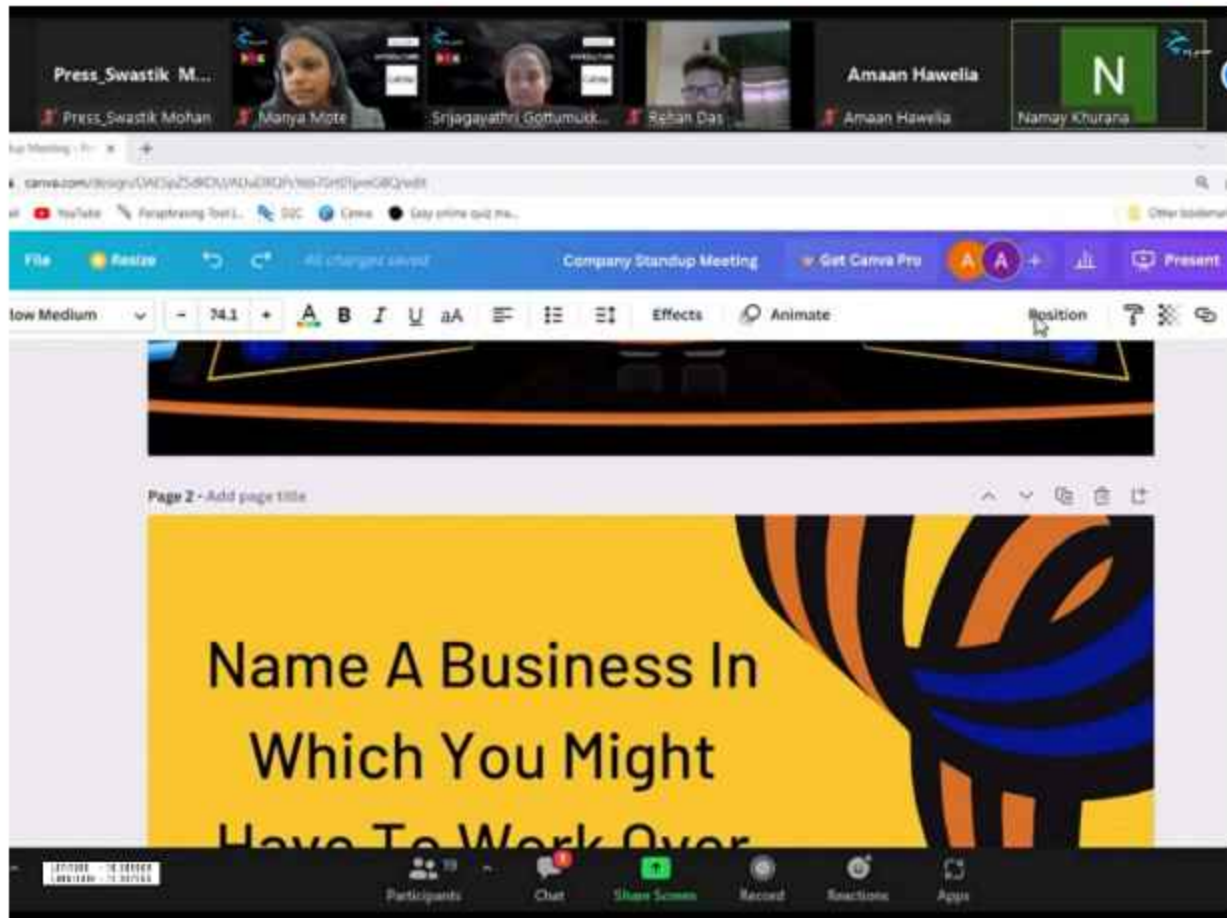
Event Summary:

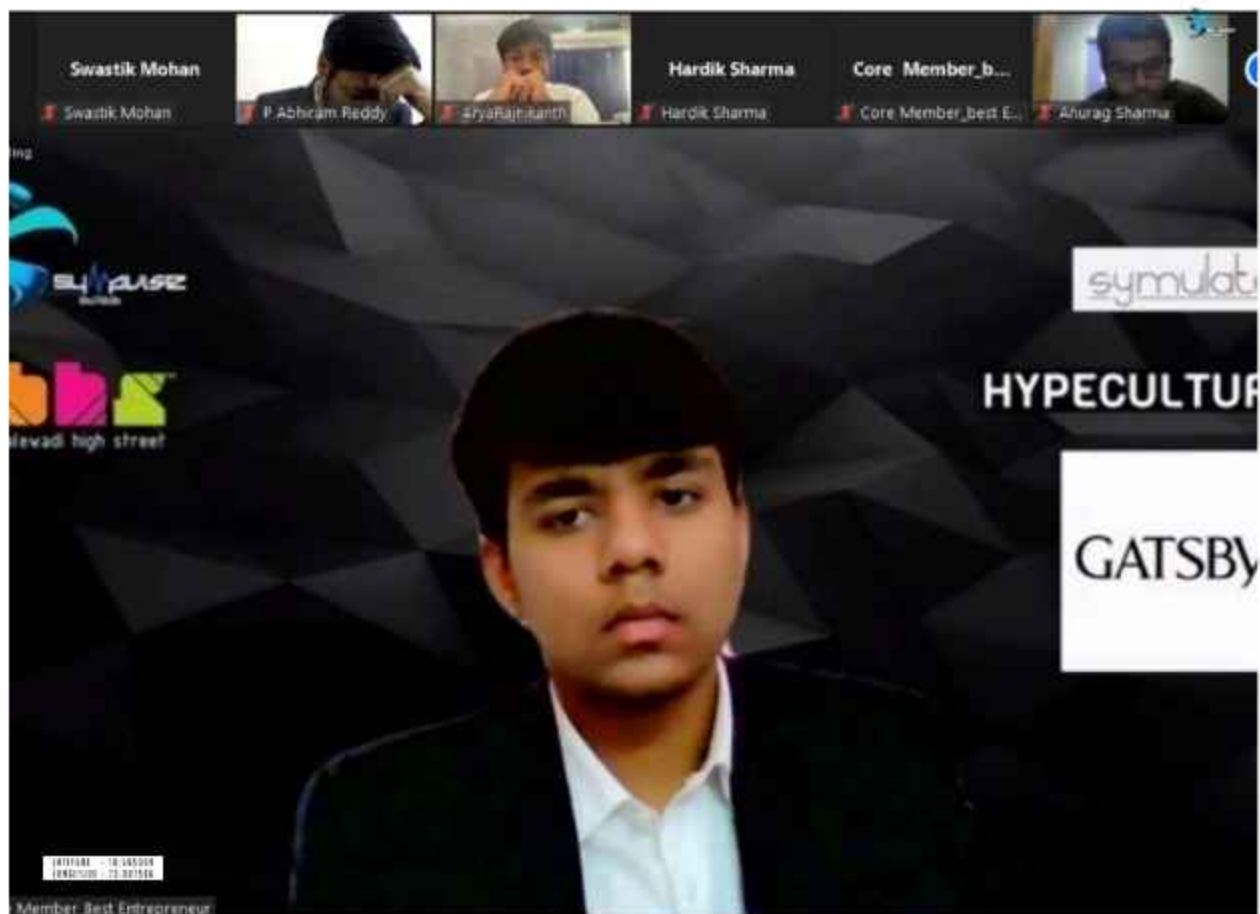
Event Summary:

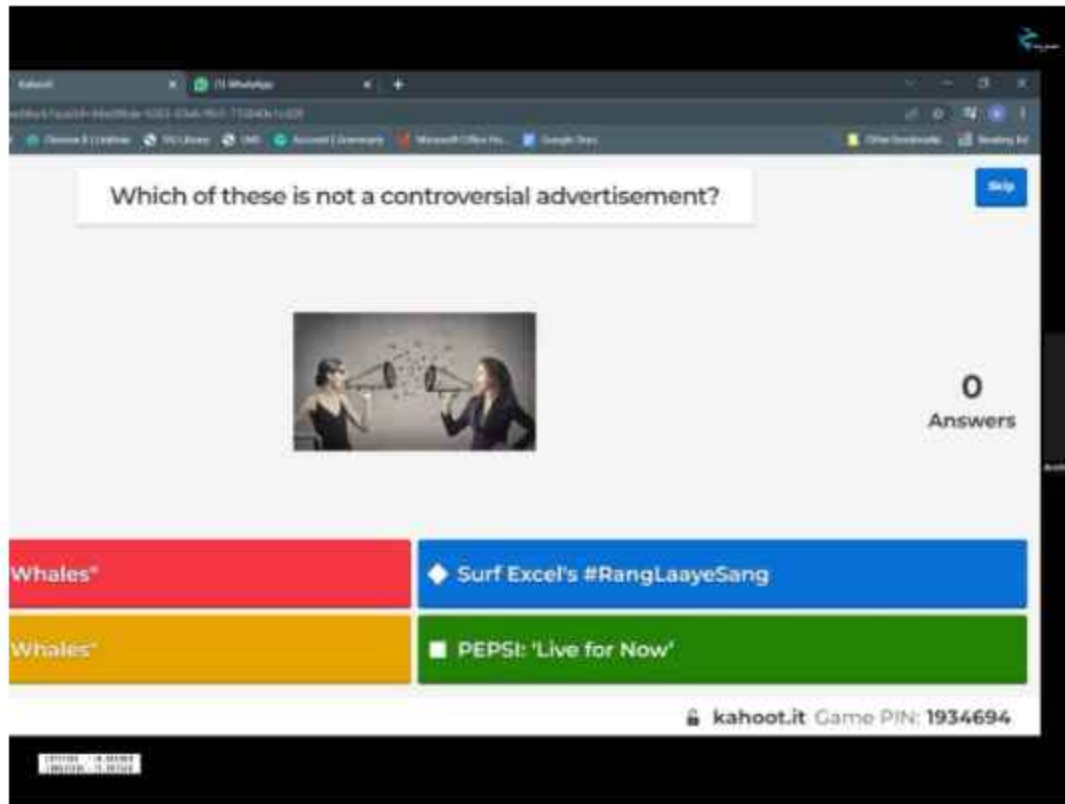

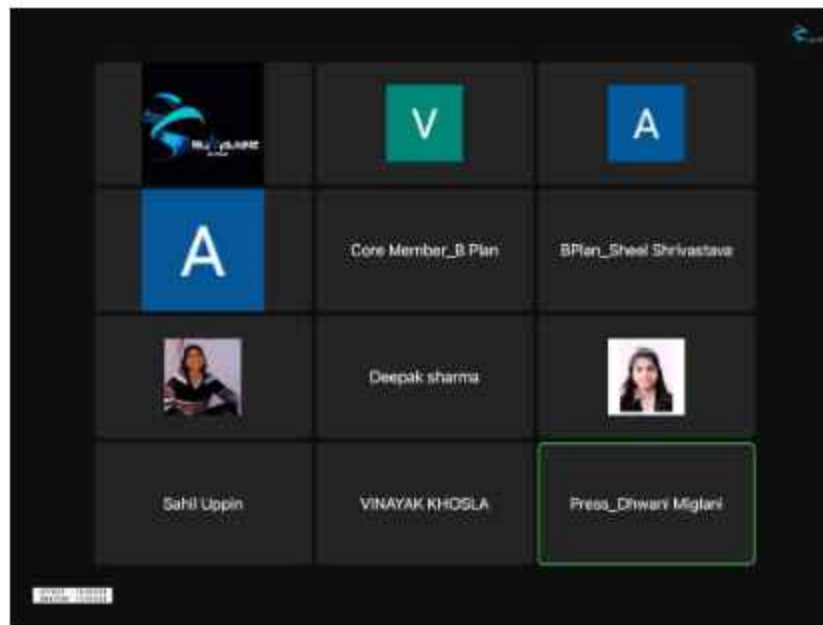
