On Day 1, the committee discussed the reservation policies of India and how the current system of reservations is responsible for the underrepresentation of SC and ST communities. Additionally, the

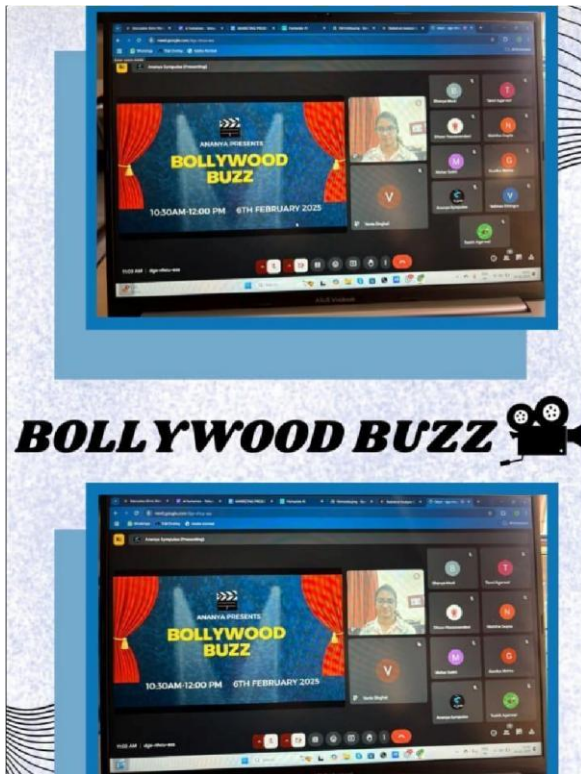
